All nominations for Elected Director positions must have the signature of four (4) voting stakeholders, other than the nominee, that support the nomination. These positions are open to registered voting stakeholders operating a tourism business in one of the aforementioned jurisdictions.

Elections will take place electronically during the period of August 17, 2020 to September 3, 2020. The results of this election will be announced at the Association’s Annual General Meeting in October at a location and date to be announced.
